VirtualWardrobeAI is a refined, AI-powered virtual wardrobe and personal styling system, designed for shoppers who want certainty before they buy. Upload a single photo and your measurements to build a photo-accurate avatar, then try on real garments before they ever reach your cart.

This manual is your complete guide to the experience — from your first avatar to your first confident, well-fitted purchase.

Getting Started

Create Your Account

- Sign up using your email or a social login.
- Complete your profile for a personalized experience.
- Select your plan — Premium unlocks unlimited imports, uploads, and try-on sessions.

Upload Your First Photo

Your avatar begins with one clear, full-body photograph. This single image is the foundation of every try-on and fit recommendation you will receive.

Best Lighting & Posture

- Stand straight, facing the camera directly.
- Use soft, even, natural lighting.
- Keep arms relaxed at your sides.
- Choose a plain, uncluttered background.

One-Time Body Measurement

A one-time manual measurement, taken with a soft measuring tape, gives the fit engine a more precise picture of your proportions to work from alongside your photo.

Measure the Following

- Bust / Chest
- Waist
- Hips
- Shoulders
- Inseam
- Torso length

Enter these values under **Body & Measurements**.

ACCURACY TIP

Photo-based estimation is a strong starting point — pairing it with manual measurements gives the system a more precise foundation, producing a closer match between your avatar and your true proportions.

Creating Your Avatar

Your avatar is generated from three inputs, working together:

- Your uploaded photograph
- The measurements you provide
- AI-assisted body-shape estimation

You may update your avatar at any time — upload a new photo or revise your measurements, and your avatar refreshes automatically.

Uploading Your Wardrobe

There are two ways to bring garments into your closet.

Import from a Retailer

Paste a product link from a supported retailer — including FashionNova, SHEIN, Temu, Boohoo, and PLT — and the item's photo, size chart, and material details are pulled in automatically.

Upload a Garment You Own

Photograph an item you already own, add its name, category, and material, and it joins your closet alongside your imports — clearly tagged so the two are easy to tell apart.

Categories include:

- Tops
- Bottoms
- Dresses
- Shoes
- Accessories
- Outerwear

Building Outfits

Once your closet holds a few pieces, combine them into complete looks — top, bottom, and shoes — to see how they read together, not just how one item fits alone.

- Mix and match directly from your closet.
- Favorite or pin the combinations you return to most.
- Save outfits to revisit later or compare before purchase.

Virtual Try-On

How It Works

- 1 Select an item from your Closet or Imported Products.
- 2 Tap **Try On**.
- 3 Your avatar renders the garment in seconds.
- 4 Review the fit feedback that accompanies it (see Section 8).
- 5 Save the session, or add the piece to a saved outfit.

Fit Prediction Engine

Using your avatar and measurements, the engine evaluates:

- Tightness
- Looseness
- Length
- Shoulder fit
- Waist fit
- Hip fit

Fit notes are written in plain language, for example:

- “Slightly tight through the bust”
- “True to size at the waist”
- “Runs loose through the hips”

A specific size recommendation accompanies each try-on, based on the garment's true measurements — not its size label alone.

Shopping & Retailer Import

VirtualWardrobeAI connects directly to the fast-fashion retailers you already shop — so you can try before you buy, without changing your routine.

- Import any product link from FashionNova, SHEIN, Temu, Boohoo, or PLT.
- Save items to a wishlist to try on or revisit later.
- Compare fit predictions across similar pieces before you decide.

More retailers are added over time — and any item can be added manually by uploading a photo, regardless of where it came from.

Important Disclaimer

Virtual try-on results may vary slightly from real-world fit. Your avatar is generated using AI body-shape estimation together with your uploaded photo and measurements. Lighting, posture, clothing material, and camera angle can all affect accuracy. For the most precise results, complete the one-time manual measurement described in Section 3, and keep your measurements current.

Privacy & Safety

- Your photos are used only to build your avatar and generate try-on renders.
- You may delete your photos and avatar at any time from your account settings.
- Your measurements are stored securely and are never shared with retailers.
- You control which items appear in your closet and may remove any item at any time.

Troubleshooting

Try-On Looks Distorted

- Retake your photo with better, more even lighting.
- Stand straight, facing the camera directly.
- Choose a plain, uncluttered background.
- Confirm your measurements are current.

Avatar Looks Slightly Off

This is normal — your avatar is an AI-generated approximation. Updating your photo or measurements can refine it further.

Clothing Doesn't Fit Correctly

Update your manual measurements under Body & Measurements for the most accurate predictions.
